**SHROVE TUESDAY PANCAKE SUPPER** On **Tuesday, February 21st at 6:00 p.m.** in the Great Hall, The Men of Bethel (MoB) are hosting a Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper. **All Bethel families are encouraged to come and bring guests.** The menu features plain, blueberry and chocolate chip pancakes as well as ham and sausages. Coffee and other beverages will be served. A free-will donation opportunity will be available at the door.

**LENTEN SCHEDULE** Ash Wednesday is the first day of Lent. On this day, Christians focus on their complete sinfulness and the necessity of Christ's suffering and death to insure their salvation. Ashes are referred to many times in the Old Testament as signs of sorrow, mourning, humility, and repentance, and on Ash Wednesday they are used to remind people of their mortality -- that "you are dust, and to dust you shall return" (Genesis 3:19). Many churches use ashes during Ash Wednesday worship in which ashes are mixed with a small amount of oil and applied to the forehead of each worshipper. This year, **Ash Wednesday service** will be on **February 22<sup>nd</sup> at 7:15 p.m.** Then, each week beginning **February 29** through **March 28** there will be a **Lenten Soup Supper at 6:00 p.m.**, followed by a short (30-45 min) worship service at **7:15 p.m.**

**FIRST COMMUNION TRAINING** – grades K-4 **Please register by Sunday, March 11** for your child in kindergarten thru 4th grade to receive first communion instruction. Forms may be found online and on the table in the narthex. Classes are scheduled for March 18<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>st</sup>. Students and a parent or

godparent must attend both sessions, which will include a lunch, following the late service. Students participating in this session of instruction will receive their first communion on Palm Sunday, April 1st.

**NURSERY HELP STILL NEEDED** - I'm sure most of us remember what it was like as a parent with a young child. More often than not, a parent ends up missing out on weeks of worship, or passes up the opportunity to become involved in the choir and bells, and various other serving opportunities during worship Sunday mornings. In relationship to our faith, we understand how important it is to worship on Sunday morning, regardless of our age or stage in life. So take a moment to look through your calendar and find a Sunday and a service that you would be willing to donate to the nursery, or if you would like to serve on a more regular basis that would be appreciated as well! **SERVE JANUARY AND FEBRUARY HIGHLIGHTS** Thank you for your continuous support of bringing food for the SERVE food distribution center. It is a 365 day a year need. Although all non-perishable foods are needed we are highlighting breakfast foods for January and February.

**RE-KEYING THE CHURCH** For years, people at Bethel have talked about the need to re-key the church: locks that don't work, too many keys, little key control, difficulty getting people where they need to be in the building. The date has been set and plans are in place to re-key and, where necessary, replace locks. To minimize the impact on people using the building, the locks will be changed on Monday, February 20. If you or your group currently has a key, please make arrangements with Debbie Mullinax in the church office to drop off your old key(s) and get a new key assigned to you. You may pick up your new keys during regular office hours (8:00a - 3:00p) after the 20<sup>th</sup>. To help accommodate those who cannot come by the church during those hours, Debbie will be available until 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 21<sup>st</sup>.

**ELCA Malaria Campaign** For many years the ELCA has been working with different programs in Africa to provide health care. We as Lutherans are now focusing on malaria more than ever before because it is a treatable and preventable disease. Despite these facts, malaria kills 800,000 people each year, most of whom are children under five. In 2011, the ELCA Churchwide Assembly voted to approve the ELCA Malaria Campaign and committed to raise \$15 million by 2015 to help prevent, treat and educate communities in Africa about malaria and eliminate deaths from this disease—for good. The youth at Bethel along with the Far Team will participate in the ELCA Malaria Campaign this year from January to March. The Sunday school offering will be designated for this cause and you are also invited to participate. Just \$10 is enough to provide a family with an insecticide-treated mosquito net and the kids at Bethel want to see how many we can donate!
